THE GOVERNMENT IS CURRENTLY **ATTACKING YOUR RIGHTS!**

You know and feel every day in your life the racist and xenophobic arguments used by the PSD/CDS government, the IL, and Chega to justify a wide range of policies that are being pursued.

Whether it is the ongoing attack on the National Health Service, public education, social security, the housing shortage, or even labor laws, we know perfectly well that immigrant workers are not to blame.

We know that it is the political choices of this and previous governments that are responsible for the attack on labor rights and the destruction of public services. We know that immigrant workers work and contribute to the country's development and that the weakening of their living conditions and permanence in Portugal is in the interests of those who exploit them in companies and workplaces. It is in their interests to exploit all workers, including immigrants. That is why, in order to defeat the offensive by the PSD/CDS government, with the support of IL and Chega, unity among all is necessary.

The government's labor package serves to satisfy the wishes of employers, who want to have disposable workers at their service, with poverty wages, increasingly irregular working hours, and fewer rights, instead of serving to resolve the problems that already exist in the law, with rules that harm workers and need to be repealed.

The same employers who intensify the exploitation of immigrant workers and who are seeking to blame those who are only looking for a better life.

THE GOVERNMENT WANTS TO:

- attack wages
- make it easier to dismiss workers
- further deregulate working hours
- increase precarious employment and perpetuate job insecurity
- attack maternity and paternity rights
- destroy collective bargaining
- limit trade union freedom and the right to strike in order to weaken the power and struggle of workers

A BETTER LIFE IS POSSIBLE FOR EVERYONE WHO LIVES AND WORKS IN PORTUGAL!

It is urgent to distribute the wealth created by those who produce it with their labor and by all those who have spent their lives working.

It is essential to hold accountable those who promote this course of action and those who profit from it: the government and employers.

CGTP-IN, YOUR UNION, DEMANDS:

- An increase in wages for all workers of at least 15%, not less than €150, to restore purchasing power and improve living conditions.
- The valorization of careers and professions;
- The setting of the National Minimum Wage at €1,000 in 2025;
- The restoration of the right to collective bargaining;
- A reduction in working hours to 35 hours per week for all, without loss of pay;
- An end to the deregulation of working hours, adaptability regimes, time banks, and all attempts to generalize continuous workday and shift work;
- Combat to precariousness;
- Strengthening investment in public services, the social functions of the State, the National Health Service, public schools, social security, justice, and the valorization of public administration workers, to ensure better services for the population;
- Guarantee to the right to housing.
