Project Overview & Key Activities

The METALLICA project aims to strengthen workers' participation in the metal sector during the twin transition, ensuring dispute prevention and improved social dialogue across Europe. Through coordinated research, national case studies, and capacity-building activities, the project supports trade unions, employers, and workers in navigating digital and green transformations.



Key activities include the development of two major publications:

1. "Dispute Prevention and Resolution in the Face of Twin Transition"
2. "Twin Transition Manual for the Metal Sector"

Both publications are based on seven national research reports and extensive consultation with social partners. In parallel, the project is creating a multilingual Twin Transition Online Platform that will transform the manual into an interactive digital tool featuring learning modules, case studies, and practical materials.

To enhance skills and knowledge, online training sessions were implemented in six countries, alongside face-to-face sessions in Bulgaria. These trainings focus on dispute prevention, workers' rights, and mechanisms of participation during restructuring.

The project is supported by structured activities, ensuring transparency, quality, and effectiveness throughout implementation, and its outputs will be available for use long after the project ends.
